

Re: Clinical trials and the NIH

My piece of 17 February entitled "Clinical trial publication types" gave fractions of all full length, English language, publications indexed to clinical trial publication types. The good news was that clinical trials represent an increasing fraction of all publications over time.

Now the bad news. The number of trials with NIH funding is declining, based on registrations in <u>ClinicalTrials.gov</u>. The counts below are for initial registration based on "1st received" dates in the registration website.
