Re: Registration dates versus start dates on CT.gov

Trials are supposed to be registered before or on the day started. The ICMJE underscored this point in its edict of 2004 requiring that trials be registered on or before starting to be eligible for publication in ICMJE journals.

The percentages started before being registered have decreased over time but still over 25% in year 2020 meaning more than a quarter of trials would not be eligible for publication by ICMJE standards.
